

Chapter 113: Mobile or Temporary Restaurant Ordinance

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113.01 PURPOSE:

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the operator(s) of any mobile restaurant or temporary restaurant in the Village of Pepin. All operators shall comply with the requirements of this ordinance.

It is unlawful for any person(s) to operate a mobile or temporary restaurant, as defined below, on public or private property within the Village of Pepin without first obtaining a permit from the Village Clerk. Permits (\$200 annually) will only be granted upon verification of a state approved license and liability insurance. If operating on private property, they shall produce written permission from the property owner or lessee. Operation on public property shall be limited to special events, which shall be pre-approved by the Village Board. Only one (1) vendor is allowed per commercially zoned private property location which cannot be within 200' of a restaurant establishment, unless approved by that establishment. The Village Board shall have the right to waive or alter permit fees on a case-by-case basis. This ordinance shall be in effect for one (1) year from the date of Village Board approval and may then be renewed or rescinded each year thereafter.

113.02 DEFINITIONS:

Mobile Restaurant defined: A restaurant operating from a movable vehicle, pushcart, trailer, or boat, which periodically or continuously changes location and wherein meals, lunches, snacks, etc. are prepared or served or sold to the general public, excepting those vehicles used in the delivery of pre-ordered meals or lunches prepared in a licensed restaurant. “*Mobile Restaurant*”, does not include a common carrier regulated by the state or federal government. A “*Temporary Restaurant*”, aka “*Pop Up*” restaurant, means a restaurant that operates at a fixed location in conjunction with a single event such as a fair, carnival, public exhibition, anniversary sale, customer appreciation, occasional sales promotion, etc..

113.03 VIOLATIONS:

- (1) No permit
- (2) Operation on private property without permission
- (3) Operation on public property


113.99 PENALTY:

Any person who violates or refuses to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture as per Village of Pepin Ordinance 10.99 and is adopted by reference. Each day a violation exists, or continues, shall be considered a separate violation. Where /when appropriate, injunctive relief may be sought by the Village of Pepin against continuing violations.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
