Map Restoration and Framing Project

Pepin Public Library

The Pepin Public Library has been given a plat map of Pepin



County, dated 1877 and a Village of Pepin street map, dated 1886. Both maps have been stored for years and have damage that needs to be repaired.

The plat map is flaking away from the backing and is dirty. The village map has water and rodent damage. The maps are currently at the Midwest Arts Conservation Center being cleaned and stabilized. Restoration costs are \$4,500; framing costs are expected to be another \$1,500.



When the maps are returned, they will be framed and placed on permanent display in the library.
