

§ 72.55 TITLE AND PURPOSE. ALL-TERRAIN/ UTILITY TASK VEHICLES

(A) The title of this subchapter is the all-terrain/utility task vehicles, regarding the operation of all-terrain/utility task vehicles upon the roadways and alleys in the village.

(B) Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density, and history of automobile traffic, this subchapter has been created.

§ 72.56 AUTHORITY.

The village has the specific authority to adopt this subchapter under Wis. Stat. § 23.33(8)(b) and (11).

§ 72.57 DESIGNATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTES.

All-terrain vehicles may be operated on all village streets except for State Highway 35.

§ 72.58 CONDITIONS.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 23.33(8)(d) and Ch. 73 of this title, the following restrictions are placed on the use of the village roadways and alleys for all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle routes designated by this subchapter.

(A) Operation shall be subject to all provisions of Wis. Stat. § 23.33(3), which is adopted and incorporated as part of this ordinance.

(B) All all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle operators shall observe speed limits not to exceed 25 mph on village roadways and ten mph on alleys. On County Road CC and County Road N (Dunn Street), the speed limit is as posted.

(C) All all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicle operators shall proceed single file.

(D) No person shall operate either an ATV or UTV on any of the designated routes (village streets or alleys) subject to this subchapter who fails to meet all of the following conditions:

(2) Each operator born on or after January 1, 1988 shall hold a valid safety certificate as defined at Wis. Stat. § 23.33(5)(d);

(3) All operators are responsible for obtaining and confirming valid insurance is in force for liability, medical, and property damage;

(4) All ATV/UTVs shall be registered and properly display registration; and

(5) Operators and passengers under 18 years of age must wear a helmet.

§ 72.59 ENFORCEMENT.

This subchapter shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the state and the village.

§ 72.99 PENALTIES

Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which no specific penalty is otherwise provided shall be punished as provided in § 10.999
